**CACCF offers a contingent designation as a stepping stone to the International Certified Alcohol and Drug Counsellor (ICADC)**

CACCF recognizes that many addiction practitioners find the process for the ICADC somewhat difficult early in their career. At the same time there is a need to ensure that those who want to have a professional status have the skills and knowledge to effectively practice in the best interests of our clients. To meet both these needs, CACCF has developed a designation that has less requirements of the recognized international certification with the intent that those practitioners will continue onto the full certification within a three year period. **The contingent designation can not be renewed.**

Candidates are required to submit a portfolio outlining their work experience and education and then successfully complete a written exam to demonstrate knowledge and competency. The cost for the portfolio review and written test is \$119.05 (+ applicable tax).
